Dear and affectionate Drother and Sister with much pleasure and gratification of mind I now imbrace this most acceptable opportunity of menewing our covenant

by way of letter and of informing of you that I received your acceptable and kind letter of August the 6th which letter I received the 1st day of September. We are all well accept one of my daughters she has been sick some two or three wooks now with something like the ague and fever, and we hambly thank fed the Civer of all Good for thus fare bestowing his kine and loving mercies tower-b as all, hoping that these few inclosed lines may come to hand and find you all in good health. Your letter gave us all great satisfaction to hear that you was still on mercies side of Eternity and was enjoying a reasonable portion of heal with your fellow mortals. You stated that you assidentally and unexpectedly received intelligence from the mouth of stephen mayfield of my place of residen I now can inform you that unexpectedly did I receive your letter also. Your letter informs me that Mayfield told you I bought his fathers farm but that is a rong information of mayfield for I purchased it of Sampson williams and Esq. Cray altho mayfield may be excused for telling you so for when I bought my far mayfields father lived on it and stephen was small and young at that time and r doubt he though I bought it from his father. It was a valuable tract of land I on rearing river about 4 miles and a half from its mouth and about 6 miles from Cainsborough. It lies all in a body together we have the Cumberland River run near us which makes navigation advantageous to us. The land that I hold are w between two and three thousand dolla at a low calculation. I have me a grist; built on my spring branch and has been running a still about 16 years and grin my own corn and stills it myself. The reason that I did not move to that coun when I came home I found that I could purchase the farm that I now live on and the reason that I never have wrote to you was because you talked of moving fro
