&nbsp;of William Martin and Mary Polly Fearney  
and Witnessed by Stanwix Hord: by Ruby Sharp

Know all Men by these Presents that we William Martin & Stanwix Hord are held firmly bound unto James Monroe Esq. governor of State of Virginia in the just & full sum of One hundred and fifty dollars Current Money. To which payment well and truly to be made to the said governor and his ????? ?? for the time being, we bind ourselves & each of us, one and each of our Heirs Executors or Adm.&quot; jointly & Severally firmly by these presents Sealed with our Seals & dated this 31st day of October 1801.

Whereas there is a Marriage depending & by Gods permission Sundenly intended between the above bound William Martin & Polly Fearney. Now the condition of the above obligation is such that if there is no lawfull cause to obstruct the said Marriage. Then the above Obligation to be paid otherwise to remain in full force Power & Virtue

in presence of Stanwix Hord
