Andrew Frankforter married Elizabeth Cugler (Kugler?) in August 1826.

Born 8/11/1804

Died 1/2/1857

Buried Weston Township, Wood County, OH Section 31, T.5 N, R. 9 E.

Elizabeth was the first person buried in the Pottertown Cemetery in Weston Township. Her mother was Catherine _____ Cugler who died in the fall of 1862 at 83 years of age. Catherine's second marriage was to David Swartz (this was Swartz's second marriage). Catherine and Swartz had twins (Fortney and Burns). After Swartz's death she lived at the home of Andrew and Elizabeth Frankforter.
