I have a Joseph Atkison (1801-1856) married to a Harriet Janes Slack in 1844 Morgan County, Ohio. He is definitely a relative of my husband. (There are many spellings of the last name from Adkins to Atkinson, so very confusing)

They are listed in Vinton Co in the 1850 Census with a son, Perry, (using the last name in this census as Adkins) who is older than their marriage, and I am suspecting from a previous marriage. I recently found this child is actually Edward Perry Atkison (1835-1851) and is buried in Starr Cemetery, Hocking Co, OH along with Joseph and Harriet. His parents are listed though as J & Atkinson.

So I find a Saryann Atkison who died in 1843 (a year before Joseph married Harriet) and she is buried in a Church of Christ Cemetery in Deavertown, Morgan Co, OH. She is originally Sarah Ann Deaver and was married to a Joseph Atkison in Muskingham Co, OH, in 1825.

So far I find a number of Joseph Atkisons (many spellings) and am trying to sort them out. I am not finding, however, who is parents are or where he came from. But if it seems as though these are the 2 marriages of my Joseph Atkison. With this I can maybe proceed backward.

This Joseph Bevis Atkinson of yours, I do find in Ohio land records, but if he was born in 1788, then he is too old to be my Joseph Atkinson. I have land records for several Joseph Atkinson's from 1835-1848, not sure if they are all one or many Joseph Atkinson's. Not sure if I helped, but am willing to share information.
