

The parents of John Lea are not known. Also, note the substantial uncertainty with respect to the sons of John Lea and Ann Unknown Lea. Researchers are advised to proceed with extreme caution in this area as the Lea family of Virginia and North Carolina is difficult to understand. Please beware of the extensive undocumented "genealogy" that is in both print and on the Internet. Particular attention is called to the negligent work done by Albert E. Casey in his book Amite County Mississippi 1699-1890. The number of junk online family trees is too large to list. Let the researcher beware.

Apparently, John Lea of King and Queen County, Virginia. had wife Ann, who was dead by October 5, 1731, and two minor sons, William and James Lea (and possibly a sister Betty), who had guardians appointed for them in Spotsylvania County, Virginia, October 5, 1731. There were possibly more children, but no record of them has been found.
