&nbspThe Governor of Virginia, from 1837-40, His Excellency&nbspDavid Campbell, b. 7 Aug 1779, was the son of John, b. 20 Apr 1742 (who married Elizabeth McDonald, b. 1753);&nbspand grandson of David "White David" b. 8 Mar 1705 in Londonderry, Ulster, N. Ireland, (who married Mary Hamilton, b. 1716).

And Gov. Campbell's wife, Mary Hamilton Campbell (maiden name), was the&nbspdaughter of Col. David Campbell, b. 2 June 1753, (who married Margaret Campbell, b. 1748); and granddaughter of David "Black David" b. 1710 (who married Jane Cunningham, b. 1718).

So the granddaughter of Black David&nbspmarried the grandson of&nbspWhite David Campbell. Who says opposites don't attract? Both White and Black David lines of Campbells&nbsphave produced many distinguished public servants.
