Jas. W. Gobin, Henderson, Ky., fought at Donelson, at Murfreesboro, at Jackson, at Mission Ridge, at Rocky Face, at Resaca, at Dallas, from Dallas to Pine Mountain, where his health failed, and he was sent to a hospital, and was not again actively engaged.
