

John George and Veronica Hain came to America in 1709 from Palatinate, a state of the old German Empire lying along the Rhine. They left Europe by way of Rotterdam, Holland with Conrad Weiser's second party.

Last name also Hoehn, Hahn, and there was a John Goerge Hohn in Ulster County, NY.

Hain's first church was built on ground donated by George Hain in 1735, at the present location of the city of Wernersville, Pa. Both he and his wife died and are buried in the cemetery of the Hain's church. George Hain died in 1746 and his wife, Veronica, died about the latter part of 1756, both are buried in the very oldest part of the cemetery and the early gravestones were of limestone or sandstone, which disintegrated when, exposed to the elements. A new granite gravestone was erected over their graves in 1926 by Mr., and Mrs., Charles I. Hain, descendants.

They had ten children. Emigrated approximately 1708-1709 from Germany
