

John H. Stone Sr. had 75 grandchildren and 20 step-grandchildren.

He created a large estate, however, and sold under adverse conditions in 1922 for only \$16,000.00. He was very healthy and active until age 85, when he injured himself lifting a large rock. He was 5'8" and normally weighed 165 lbs. and was a fine athlete when he was young. He was a confederate soldier about 3 1/2 years in the Cavalry of General Nathan Bedford Forrest, much of the time a scout. He was sent to Texas during the war to secure horses.
