

Margaret Atkison 2nd generation

The third child of Joseph Sr and Harriet Janes, Margaret Atkison was born on 11 May 1848 in Vinton County, Ohio. She had five siblings, namely: Thomas, Nancy M, Exean, Samuel, and Joseph Henry.

In the 1850 Census of Elk Twp, Vinton Co, Ohio, the last name is spelled (Adkins). Joseph, her father, is age 48, Harriet is age 36, Thomas age 6, Manny age 4, **Marget (Margaret)** age 3, Perry Edward age 10, William age 19, and his wife Sarah age 20.

Both Perry and William are from Joseph 's 1st marriage.

After the death of Joseph,her father, in 1856, Margaret was listed in his Probated Will. She was 9 years old..

On April 28 1860 when Margaret was 12, Henry Janes was appointed Guardian. Henry Janes was the brother of Margaret's mother Harriet Janes Slack Atkison.

In the 1860 Census, Union, Morgon, Ohio. and in the household of Elisabeth Thompson age 57, her son Eli Thompson age 19, we find Samuel age 8, and **Margaret age 12** . Note: we assume these Atkison children were taken in after the death of Joseph Sr.

Charles Lawton Woodard and Margaret Atkison Woodard were married on 2 Jan 1870 and had 3 children:

Charles Andrew Woodard was born on 28 Feb 1867 in Starr, Hocking, Ohio, USA. He died on 02 Mar 1934 in Fort Wayne, Allen, Indiana, USA. He married Margaret Catherine Shingler Woodard on 24 Nov 1887 in Hocking County, Ohio..

Exean Woodard was born on 08 Dec 1874 in Hocking County, Ohio, USA. She died on 30 Jul 1945 in Paulding County, Ohio.

Harriet Woodard Stucky was born on 15 Feb 1877. She died on 26 Dec 1906 in Washington, Paulding,Ohio. She married John Oscar Stucky on 8 Nov 1895 in Van Wert, Van Wert, Ohio.

Note:Charles and Margaret are listed in the book Asbury Ridge by John Hampton Atkinson.

The Woodard Family History:

There was some information about the Woodard Family in the book by John Hampton Atkinson titled "Asbury Ridge, New England Outpost". It was about 1812 when Ichabod Woodard Sr. brought his family from the New York/New Jersey area to Fairfield County, Ohio. The majority of his descendents remain in Ohio.

One of Ichabod Woodard's sons was William Cooper Woodard. He was the father of Charles Lawton Woodard who would one day take Margaret Atkison as his wife.

Charles Lawton Woodard was born on 17 Mar 1842 in Hocking County, Ohio to William Cooper Woodard and wife Mary(?)

According to the 1850 Census, Charles L. was 8 years old, his father William was 41 and his mother Mary was 39. His siblings are: John 16, David 14, Mary 11, Wesley 6 and William Jr 2. They were living in Starr, Hocking County, Ohio.

The 1860 Census of Starr, Hocking County, Ohio lists William age 52, Mary H age 49, John age 26, David age 24, Charles age 18, Wesley age 16, William age 11, Sarah J. age 10, Benjamin age 9, Arthur age 6, Francis age 2.

Charles L Woodard and Margaret Atkison applied for a marriage license #5110 (copy on file) on 31 Dec 1869 in Hocking County, Ohio and were married 2 Jan 1870 by N.B. Woodard (uncle?)

By 1870 Census in Starr, Hocking County, Ohio Charles is abt. 30 and Margaret abt. age 23 and son Charles A age 2.

The last 10 years have brought growth to the family because in the 1880 Census of Starr, Hocking County, Ohio reveals Charles age 38, Margaret age 32, Charles A. age 13, Exean age 9, Harriet age 6.

Sometime before 1892, Margaret filed for divorce and before the 1900 Census, it shows Charles age 57 to be a resident of the Athens State Hospital in Athens, Ohio and is still a resident in 1910.

He died 30 Dec 1911 in Athens, Ohio and is buried in the Middle Creek Cemetery, Washington, Paulding County, Ohio.

Margaret married William Wooley on 11 Feb 1892 in Van Wert County, Ohio by Elder J. M. Stone.

They were married only 5 months before her death on 30 July 1892 in Washington, Paulding County, Ohio. She is buried there in the Middle Creek Cemetery.

There were no children born to Margaret Atkison Woodard Wooley and William Wooley.
