[In the final settlement of Andrew and Elizabeth's estate, son George Bell itemized the following charge: "Mr. BARWICK: headstone for father, mother & sister Sylvia \$110.00."

Since the tombstone was erected sometime after Elizabeth's death in August 1905, the family was mistaken about the actual year of death of both Andrew and Sylvia, but knew correctly that the father died 10 years after the daughter. This explains why both death dates are incorrect.]
