Noah FRANKFORTER, b. 24 Jan 1849 near Youngstown OH, d. Lincoln General Hospital, Lincoln NE 1 Jul 1942, aged 94y, 5m, 7d. On 2 Jun 1870 he m. Sally Ann PAULIN in (Wood) OH and on 13 Jan 1871 they came to Lincoln NE and homesteaded northeast of Tobias. Funeral was held 4 Jul in Tobias.

NOTES:

According to information from a descendant of Noah FRANKFORTER, sometime before his death Noah indicated that Sally Ann's mother's maiden name was BARAGER. The descendant has concluded that Lydia's father was a Mr. BARAGER, not Mr. KUGLER as claimed by other FRANKFORTER descendants in the "...History of Wood County, Ohio." To date, a marriage record has not been found for Elisabeth SWARTS and either Mr. BARAGER or Mr. KUGLER. Since Elisabeth was probably living with her parents in West Salem Twp (Mercer) PA, it is possible her first marriage occurred there. It may be that Elisabeth was not married and, since the child Lydia was baptized as Andrew FRANKFORTER's stepchild, the identity of her biological father was never recorded.

Peter PAULIN and Matilda FISHER:

Peter and Matilda were m. 7 Sep 1851 in (Mahoning) OH, almost 9 months after the death of his wife Lydia. Matilda, then 3 months shy of her 21st birthday, became the instant mother of 2 young children. Matilda was b. 25 Dec 1831 (York) PA, d/o John FISHER & Sallie FORMAN. John and Sallie FISHER were both natives of PA and were of German descent. They had 8 children: Matilda, George, John, Louis, Emanuel, Eliza, Eli and Sarah. Emanuel and Louis d. before 1884.

According to the BRETZ biography on p. 1004 of the History of Wyandot County, Ohio, Peter and Matilda PAULIN had at least 3 children. Their youngest daughter, Lucy Ann, m. Alexander James BRETZ, the only son of Andrew J. BRETZ and his wife Mary BAUM.

According to the Biography of Albert Z. WILLSON on pp 1028-1029 of the History of Wyandot County, Ohio, Peter PAULIN d. 11/712 Jul 1860, aged 36y, leaving his young widow with 4 minor children. Fourteen years later, Matilda FISHER PAULIN m(2) Albert Z. WILLSON, s/o Jacob L. WILSON and Bathsheba P. SHOTWELL. Albert was b. 20 Aug 1837, one of 7 children and m(1) 16 Jun 1859 Frances BROWN, d/o William BROWN and Elizabeth NITZ. They had 5 children: Rozella R., William L., George E., Eva A., and Sarah E. Rozella, Eva and William d. before 1884. Frances WILSON d. 16 Nov 1873 and some 9 months later Albert Z. and Matilda PAULIN were married, she being 5 years his senior.
