Death of a Bright and Eccentric Man

On the 19th ult., at his home near Salem, Missouri, Dr. J.E. Thompson died after a short illness of pneumonia. Four or five years ago he came to Placerville with his family and after a short residence, during which he practiced medicine, he suddenly returned to Mexico, whence he had come to this city.
