

The first generation in the US was Patrick Kelly (1709-1769) and possible brother Henry Kelly (1716-1786). Both are buried in Derry Presbyterian Church graveyard. Patrick was born in 1709, married Sarah Wineas in 1731 in Chester St Paul's Episcopal Church, obtained land warrants for a total of 240 acres in both 1734 and 1744 in what was originally called Paxtang but later defined as East Derry and later Londonderry in Lancaster County. This area was located in Lancaster County but was placed into Dauphin County in 1785 and then Lebanon County in 1813. I mention this in that researching the family history I have found information in the records of these three counties in Pa. As for Patrick's ancestors, I have unverified from public trees on ancestry.com a father named William and mother Mary both from Donegal, a grandfather John and great grandfather Kedaugh all from County Donegal.
