This is a comment about Sib Rich's name. Names are very interesting

and often a source of misleading confusion. Take Sib Rich.

He calls himself Sib Rich in the 1880 Clay Co census. In the Plumlee

book (in which he is listed as Martha Sim'
s husband) he is called

Eusibius Rich. He is included in several databases in Rootsweb WorldConnect. There he is called Usibius Rich.

The most interesting is his Clay Co marriage bond. I have a photocopy

of the original bond. In his own handwriting (I presume)

he calls himself "E Sibius Rich". This is clearly written 4 different

times and it is obvious that he intends " E" to be the first initial

of a first name and Sibius to be the second name.
