

WILL dated 7 of 12th mo. 1703/4 (7 Feb 1703/4 Quaker dating). Proved 8 Sep 1704, Birmingham, Chester

County, Pennsylvania. Philadelphia County Wills: Book B, page 374.

To son Nathan, 246 acre plantation (homestead) when 21.

To son Peter, 254 acres of the upper end of my tract on the other side of the Brandywine.

To eldest daughters; Hannah Thatcher, Elizabeth and Sarah Dix, the remaining 300 acres of tract of 554 acres

of the land on the other side of the Brandywine.

To daughters, Esther and Deborah Dix, 20 pounds each at age 18.

To wife Esther, remainder of estate and Executrix of estate.
