James Lea and Anne Herndon were married 1731 in King and Queen County, VA. In case you don't have it, James Lea was born : abt 1707 St. Stephens Parish, King and Queen Co., VA, d. 1792, in Caswell Co, NC. Anne died abt 1777 in Caswell County. The children of this marriage besides Isabella, Lucinda and Adelpia included: William, b. ca 1733 (I have him married to a Nancy (last name unk), William died 1794 in Wilkes Co. GA); Nancy Lea, b. abt 1736; Luke Lea b. 26 Nov 1739, d. 1813, Tchfunctu River, St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana (Luke was a captain who commanded a troop of Tories during the Revolution, and fought among other places at the Battle of Ramsour's Mill. There was a "Major Lea" at the Battle of Kings Mountain in northern SC, who I think was the same person, with the wrong rank (gets confusing when these guys are named "Major" as a family name, and then some are in the military). I'd like to know if the whole family were Tories, or just Luke. His sister Adelpia is my gggg-grandmother, and her son, Major Henderson married Mary "Polly" Stozier (my ggg-grandparents). Mary was the daughter of Peter Stozier, who was also at the Battle of Kings Mountain, but as a patriot, fighting under Gen. Elijah Clarke and Capt. Paddy Carr.

Back to the Leas: additional children (siblings of Adelpia, Lucinda and Isabella: Major Lea, b. 1742; John Lea, b. abt 1744.

I have more information on several of these Leas, but maybe I should send it to you directly instead of cluttering up this forum.
