Text: Richard Hood, b.<1755 (1800 census) [comment: Present with # 4 John Hood in Halifax Co., VA 1760s-1770s; and in Surry Co., NC 1774; and in Burke Co., NC through 1789; and in Pendleton Dist. SC 1790 census, 1800 census, but not in 1810. In the 1790 census, Richard's household appeared to contain a family of 9 children -- 4 males and 5 females. The 4 males were all under 16 -- i.e., b. not earlier than 1774. At two-year birth intervals, it seems reasonable to suppose the Richard began fathering children NLT ca.1772. No evidence has yet been found re the spouse of Richard, nor can I yet identify any of his children.

2. JOHN2 HOOD ((UNKNOWN)1) was born Bet. 1730 - 1735. He married VIOLET CHAPMAN Bef. 1762, daughter of JOSEPH CHAPMAN and SARAH (UNKNOWN). She was born Bef. 1733.

Note:

There's considerable circumstantial evidence to support a belief that the father, John HOOD was married to a Violet Chapman, and is the same John HOOD who, with wife Violet, appears in the Pendleton/Greenville Dist. records during the decade of the 1790s and the first decade of the 1800s. In 1801 the records recite two deeds executed by a John HOOD and wife Violet. It seems certain that John HOOD and wife, Violet (of Halifax Co., VA in the 1770s) were the same as John HOOD and wife, Violet, who appeared in Pendleton District,

SC no later than 1801. Where were they in the intervening years? If we stick to the notion that John HOOD and Richard HOOD were a "team", then the answer seems to be Surry Co., NC and then Burke Co., NC.

(Note from LL...this appears to match the migration pattern stated by Thomas HOOD in his Rev. War application: Thomas HOOD, s/o John. B 1762 Halifax Co., VA. Age 2 (1764) moved to Burke Co., NC where he was residing at enlistment in 1764. After Rev moved to Pendleton District SC).

Text: In 1769, the Halifax Co., VA records recite a power of attorney executed by a "Joseph Chapman of Orange Co., NC" to a "John Chapman of Halifax co., VA" pertaining to "150 acres in Prince William Co., VA, devised to the said Joseph Chapman by his father's will..."; witnesses were Henry Hereford, Richard Carter, John HOOD.

From David Bell: Thomas gives every appearance of having resided in Pendleton for a while, and then having moved across the Saluda River to Greenville. The latest documentary evidence I've seen actually placing Thomas

in Pendleton was a 1794 Pendleton deed whereby "Thomas HOOD of Pendleton District" sold 100 acres to an Edward Johnston.

From David Bell: In the decade between 1775-1785, at least 2 and quite likely 3 "sets" of HOODS (totally unrelated) migrated to Burke Co., NC from VA. 1) John HOOD m ? FRANKLIN, possible descended from a large, extended HOOD family in the area of Amelia and Dinwiddie Co., VA. 2) Tunis HOOD family. 3) "Our" John HOOD (with wife Violet Chapman?) and Richard HOOD, possibly brother. Circumstantial evidence points to their having come from the area of Prince William Co., VA, via Halifax Co., VA and Surry Co., NC. Removed to Pendleton District SC, enumerated 1790 federal census. Possible widowed sis-in-law of John and Richard and 2 sons also to Burke Co., a little later.

~Ck re children of Thomas: Greenville 1820 Elijah b 1794-1804; Greenville 1830 Elijah, Alfred, Rolly all living near John (s/o John Sr. ?) and Nipper (s/o Thomas).

Note: e-mail from David Bell: I'm now inclined to think that he's the Thomas HOOD who married Sarah Morgan in 1781 in Burke Co., NC--a recent discovery. This "fits" rather nicely with the residences of Thomas and [several] Morgans, both in Pendleton and later in Greenville (see particularly the 1800 Greenville census). [Regarding Wilkes vs Burke Co., NC] Wilkes Co. was formed 1777 from Surry Co. and Burke was formed 1777 from Rowan. In other words, pre-1777 Surry and Rowan shared a common boundary, but post-1777 the common boundary was shared by Wilkes and Burke. In 1789, a slice of northwestern Burke Co. was cut off and added to Wilkes Co. This slice comprised the area which was enumerated in the 1790 census for Wilkes Co. as the "15th Company"; and encompassed much of the area where "our" Hoods, et al., had resided.

Upon seeing the handwriting, I don't think one could have any doubt that the spelling is Hood. 1m 1790-1800 [unk], 2m 1784-1790 [Morgan, Nipper], 1m 1755-1774 [Thomas], 2f 1780-1790 [unk], 1f 1784-90 [unk], 1f 1755-1774 [Sarah].
